

Heat Policy

Suspension / Cancellation of play guidelines

The Vines Golf Club of Reynella provides the following guidelines for the Modification, Rescheduling or Cancellation of Play.

The reference temperature to be used to determine the outcome of play shall be the Adelaide Forecast from the bureau of meteorology website, www.bom.gov.au.

The forecast temperature is the estimated maximum as displayed on the BOM at 5:00pm the evening prior to play except Twilight competitions where the 11:30am update on the day of play will be used.

The Vines Golf Club Suspension / Cancellation of an Event will be authorised by one of the following:

- Manager
- Club Captain
- Match Committee

Junior Events

If the forecast temperature is 36°c or greater all Junior events and competitions will be cancelled. This includes Junior Twilights or any special Junior competition.

Junior Clinics

If the forecast temperature is 34°c or greater all Junior Clinics will be cancelled. This includes regular clinics held on Saturdays and Sundays as well as School holiday or any special clinics.

Mixed Events

If the forecast temperature is 36°c or greater all Mixed Events and competitions will be cancelled.

Twilight Competitions

If the forecast temperature is 38°c or greater the Twilight competition is cancelled.

Male Club Competitions

If the forecast temperature is 38°c or higher the competition of the day will be cancelled with any entry into any re-arranged proshop competitions entirely voluntary. This applies to the Wednesday, Saturday & Sunday Competitions including Special Guest Day.

Female Club Competitions

If the forecast temperature is 36° or higher the competition of the day will be cancelled. In it's place there will be an optional 18 hole & 9 hole competition arranged by the pro shop. The Womens Match Committee will arrange alternative dates for any special competition that was due to be held on that day.

Any change to an event or cancellation will be displayed on the club website and club notice boards.
